

SPRING 2017 e4-12 Church Schedule

The SPRING 2017 e4-12 semester will officially start on January 8th with the “Introduction Week” (no lecture for Intro Week) but churches can start showing Lecture 1 during that week if more room is needed in your church calendar. **Please choose a start date within the top row of BLUE boxes and share this schedule with your students. Note holidays you may need to plan around.** If your church shows the lectures on Thursdays through Saturdays, it is advised to start during the Intro Week. Choose the same day and time each week to show the lectures at your church and notify students promptly of any changes to the schedule. Churches may need to “double up” after the Mid Term if a week off is needed before the Final Exam.
