The Spring 2019 e4-12 semester will officially start on January 13th with the Introduction/Orientation Week (no lecture for Intro Week) but churches can start showing Lecture 1 during that week if more room is needed in your church calendar. **Please choose a start date within the top rows of BLUE boxes and share this schedule with your students. Note holidays you may need to plan around.** If your church shows the lectures on Thursdays through Saturdays, it is advised to start during the Intro Week. Choose the same day and time each week to show the lectures at your church and notify students promptly of any changes to the schedule. QUARTER DUE DATES
