The number of days for refund calculations are based on the published academic calendars for each semester.

Proportion of Total Course Completed As of the Date of Drop or Withdrawal	Tuition Refund
Less than 10%	100% refund
10% up to but not including 20%	80% refund
20% up to but not including 30%	60% refund
30% up to but not including 40%	40% refund
40% up to and including 60%	20% refund
More than 60%	No refund
