North Carolina state law (G.S. 130A-155.1) requires persons attending a college or university, whether public, private or religious, to present proof of immunization. The statute applies to all students except those residing off-campus and registering for any combination of off-campus courses, evening courses, weekend courses, or no more than four day credit hours in on-campus courses.

Footnote¹ - Those individuals enrolling in college for the first time on or after July 1, 2008 must have had three doses of tetanus/diphtheria toxoid and a booster dose of tetanus/diphtheria/pertussis vaccine if a tetanus/diphtheria toxoid or tetanus/diphtheria/pertussis vaccine has not been administered within the past 10 years.

Footnote² - Hepatitis B vaccine is not required if born before July 1, 1994.
